Legal Notice:

As the Law of the Land is about to be
changed, marriages can no longer take
place with couples under the age of
18 years with or without parental consent.
This applies to churches, chapels, registrar
offices and designated places.
You must be 18 years old to be married.
The Church still requires six months'
notice to be given before a marriage may
be celebrated,
And if you're having second thoughts
please let me know as soon as possible.
