This started on 15<sup>th</sup> October and will run into January 2024. During this time, we want to hear from as many people as possible. I am writing to you because your parish has not yet managed to nominate any lay Synod Members. Having lay and clergy from each parish is key to the Synod process: although each parish can have two Synod Members, if you are only able to find one, this would suffice.
