Watch a saint enter the church. He goes in without concerning himself with those already there. Remain quite for a moment after you have come into church: silence is the greatest mark of respect, and the first disposition of prayer is respect.

Holy Church expects profound reverence before the Blessed Sacrament, especially when it is exposed. Silence then must be still more absolute, one's behaviour still more respectful: the restraint of keeping recollected is already by itself a beautiful homage of virtue.

Protect your moments of silence and solitude: the soul needs them, and God wants them to visit souls and converse with the heart which dwells in his love. Go often to rest the silence before the tabernacle.

That is how you will renew your strength and rediscover your courage.
